1. Uninstall the Demo Program

If you installed a demo version of the program, it should be uninstalled before installing the full licensed version of RandomBots Auditor. Uninstall the installation from the Control Panel.

To open the Control Panel:

- Click Start from the Windows Toolbar
- Click Settings
- Click Control Panel
- Click Add/Remove Programs
- Locate RandomBots Auditor and choose uninstall.

Optionally, you can uninstall the demo using Windows Explorer:

- Locate the installation folder in the left panel of Windows Explorer and double click it to expose its files in the right panel of the window.
- Locate **unins000.exe** and double click to execute the uninstall program.
- Locate the installation folder in the left panel of Windows Explorer.
- Right click the folder to highlight it and activate a popup menu.
- Choose **Delete**.

Installation of RandomBots Auditor indicates your acceptance of these terms. By purchase, use, or acceptance of RandomBots Auditor you further agree to comply with all export laws and regulations of the United States as such laws and regulations may exist from time to time.

No specific warranties exist. However, if any errors are discovered that make RandomBots Auditor inoperable, none are known to exist at this time, we will make every effort, within our abilities, to remedy the reported error and provide a program upgrade.

3. Support

Users should have a general understanding of the Windows Operating system.

4. Installation from Disc

Insert the CD into the drive and start Windows Explorer.

To expose the files on the CD, double click the icon that represents the drive for the CD on your computer. To start the installation double click **setup.exe** where it appears in the panel on the right side of the window.

5. Installation from Download

Click the URL provided in your email or type the address into your Internet browser to start the download. See the document about the download procedure for detailed instructions about downloading.

After the download is complete choose the open option to immediately start the installation or save it for installation at a later time. To install on a computer other than the one to which it was downloaded, save the file to a Zip disk or CD and move it to the machine on which it will install.

If you save to install later, use Microsoft's Windows Explorer to locate and double click the file (RB_Audit_Install.exe) to start the installation.

6. Installing the Program

The setup program will install the system into the folder - C:\Program Files\RB_Auditor.

If required, setup will allow you to specify the installation folder.

After the installation is complete, the RandomBots Auditor Icon will appear on your desktop. Double click it to start the program.

7. Creating a Diskette (3.5" Disk) Backup of the Installation Program

Your email instructions will also provide an option to download an installation that includes files to create a backup installation on 3.5" diskettes.

To create a 3.5" diskette backup, you will need two 3.5" disks with the full capacity of each disk available for writing – empty and formatted:

- Download the alternate installation file (RB_Audit_Install_Alt.exe).
- Install and run the program
- Click the **Utils** menu at the top of the program window
- Choose **Create Installation Diskettes**
- Follow program's prompts
- Put the disks in a safe place for reinstallation if required

8. The Help System

The program help system provides all the information necessary to successfully generate, save and print random samples. From the program window, click the Help button to start the RandomBots Help System.

The RandomBots Auditor Help System is written using some of the most current technology from Microsoft. Sometimes, unfortunately, that means incompatibility problems with older systems.

Your computer must have Microsoft Internet Explorer version 4.0, or later, installed, or RandomBots Auditor's Help System may not function properly or may not be accessible at all. Even if you do not access the Internet from the machine on which the program is installed, or you use another Internet browser, Microsoft's Internet Explorer must be installed.

If the help system is not accessible and Internet Explorer version 4.0, or later, is installed, follow the instructions outlined in the solution below.

Install Internet Explorer, version 5.01. If the help system is still not accessible then the final solution for this problem will be to run the HTML update: hhupd.exe from Microsoft. This has fixed all the trouble we've seen with out of date versions of Internet Explorer

The latest version of Microsoft's Internet Explorer is available free from Microsoft's Web Site. hhupd.exe is included with the installation and is copied to the installation folder. Using Windows Explorer, expose the files in the Randomware installation folder and double click hhupd.exe to update other Internet Explorer modules and components used with the help system.

Note: hhupd.exe contains Microsoft update modules and components.

9. Program Fonts for the Screen & Printing

You may need to set the print fonts before you can properly print documents through RandomBots. The default fonts do not seem to be active for all installations

There are four print font categories:

- Primary Title
- Secondary Title
- Column Headings
- Line Data

And two screen font categories:

- Data Input
- Screen Text (data screen column headings and titles)

When the font control dialog is displayed, set all fonts to Arial, Regular, and Size 8 to insure that all data fits on a page. Be certain the option boxes for "Strikeout" and "Underline" are not checked.

See the articles in the help system under Printing, Fonts & Colors. You will find articles there discussing the default fonts and the methods by which fonts are specified and controlled. You only have to set the fonts once. Once set, they remain well maintained and need no further attention.

Note: Samples of reports can be found on the website in Adobe Acrobat reader format (PDF files). Most installations of Microsoft Windows have a copy of the Adobe Acrobat Reader. If you double click on a PDF file it usually opens in the system's Internet browser.

If your installation doesn't include this resource, it's available free from Adobe's website.

10. Color Control – Setting the Display Properties for your Monitor

The pre-selected color settings used by RandomBots will display best if the color palette for your monitor is set to more than 256 colors. If more than 256 colors are not available then refer to Help for assistance with color control. See the help system for an example of incorrect color settings.



To easily access the display control function click your left mouse button over the “Desktop” and click “Properties” as shown on the right.

Optionally, you can access display control from the “Control Panel.”

Once the display control dialog is displayed, select the “Settings” tab and a color palette greater than 256.

Windows 2000 will present a dialog box as below. Display properties for Windows 95 & 98 are similar.
